THE ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATION (SCOTLAND) CHARGING SCHEME 2016

The Scottish Environment Protection Agency in exercise of its powers under section 41 of the Environment Act 1995 and regulation 11 and Schedule 5 of the Water Environment (Controlled Activities) (Scotland) Regulations 2011, and with the approval of the Scottish Ministers, makes the following Charging Scheme.

PART 1

GENERAL

Commencement, extent and citation

1. This charging scheme shall -

(a) be referred to as the Environmental Regulation (Scotland) Charging Scheme 2016 ("this Scheme");

(b) extend only to Scotland;

(c) come into force on 1st April 2016; and

(d) remain in force until revoked.

Interpretation: general

2. In this Scheme –

"the 1989 Act" means the Control of Pollution (Amendment) Act 1989;

"the 1990 Act" means the Environmental Protection Act 1990;

"the 1993 Act" means the Radioactive Substances Act 1993;

"the 2014 Act" means the Regulatory Reform (Scotland) Act 2014;

"the CA Regulations" means the Water Environment (Controlled Activities) (Scotland) Regulations 2011;

"the PPC Regulations" means the Pollution Prevention and Control (Scotland) Regulations 2012;

"the WML Regulations" means Waste Management Licensing (Scotland) Regulations 2011;

"abstraction" and "impounding" have the meanings given in the Water Environment and Water Services (Scotland) Act 2003;

"activity" means an activity described in column 4 of the Table in the Schedule, which is required to be carried on under an authorisation;

"annual charge" means a charge described in paragraph 10;

“application” means an application for an authorisation or to vary, modify, transfer, surrender, renew, cancel or revoke, an authorisation or to partially transfer or surrender an authorisation;

“application charge” means a charge described in paragraph 8;

“authorisation” means -

- (a) a permit under the PPC Regulations,
- (b) an authorisation or registration under the 1993 Act,
- (c) a registration under the WML Regulations,
- (d) a registration under the 1989 Act,
- (e) a registration or licence under the CA Regulations,
- (f) a licence under the 1990 Act,
- (g) an authorisation under Regulations made under the 2014 Act;

“financial year” means the 12 months ending on 31 March;

“relevant time and materials costs” means those costs and expenses incurred by SEPA in the determination of an application or the annual regulation of a permit, based on an hourly rate of £87, as notified from time to time by SEPA to the authorisation holder;

"SEPA" means the Scottish Environment Protection Agency.

Annual adjustments

3. Charges under this Scheme shall increase or decrease annually in each year from 1st April 2017, in line with changes in the Retail Prices Index published by the Office for National Statistics as at 30 September in the immediately preceding year, rounded up to the nearest pound.

Liability to pay charges

4. The persons set out below shall be liable to pay the charges under this Scheme –

- (a) In respect of an application charge, the person or persons –
 - (i) applying to hold an authorisation,
 - (ii) holding the authorisation to which the application relates,
 - (iii) applying for the transfer of an authorisation, or
 - (iv) where relevant, the person on whom an authorisation or variation is imposed by SEPA, and

(b) In respect of an annual charge, the holder of the authorisation in respect of which the charge is payable, or in the case of a licence under the 2011 Regulations, the responsible person within the meaning of those Regulations.

Time of payment

5. Charges payable under this Scheme shall be due and payable in full at the following times on or after the 1st April 2016 -

(a) In respect of an application charge (except those which relate to application amendments or advertisements or which consist of relevant time and materials costs), on the making of the application to SEPA, or the imposition of the authorisation or variation by SEPA;

(b) In respect of an annual charge, annually on 1 April except in the first year in which an authorisation is granted or the charge becomes payable, where the charge is payable on demand;

(c) In respect of all other charges, on demand.

Revocation

6. The following charging schemes which came into effect on 1st April 2015 are revoked in so far as they relate to any period on or after 1st April 2016 -

- (a) The Pollution Prevention and Control Fees and Charges (Scotland) Scheme 2015,
- (b) The Radioactive Substances Fees and Charges (Scotland) Scheme 2015, but only in relation to premises referred to in that Scheme as “Band B premises” or “Band C premises”,
- (c) The Waste Management Exemptions (Scotland) Schedule 1 (paragraphs 7, 8,(2), 9, 10, 12, 19, 42, 46 and 47) Fees and Charges Scheme 2015,
- (d) The Waste Management Fees and Charges (Scotland) Scheme 2015,
- (e) The Water Environment (Controlled Activities) Fees and Charges (Scotland) Scheme 2015.

PART 2

CHARGES FOR APPLICATIONS

Interpretation of this Part

7. In this Part –

“application activity charge” means the charge listed in column 5 of the Table in the Schedule;

“administrative application” means an application which SEPA considers to be of a purely administrative nature;

“assessed transfer application” means an application for the transfer of an authorisation which is subject to assessment;

“energy efficiency assessment application” means an application to which Schedule 1A of the PPC Regulations applies;

“imposed authorisation” means an authorisation imposed by SEPA in exercise of its powers;

“minor technical variation application” means an application for the variation or modification of an authorisation which SEPA considers to be of a minor technical nature;

“substantial application amendment” means a request to amend an application which SEPA considers requires public consultation;

“technical variation or surrender application” means an application for the variation, modification, surrender, cancellation or revocation of an authorisation, which does not fall within any other definition in this paragraph.

Applications

8. (1) An application charge is payable for an application and an imposed authorisation.

(2) Subject to sub-paragraph (3), the application charge for each type of application and imposed authorisation described in column 1 of Table 1 shall be the applicable charge set out in column 2.

(3) (a) Where more than one activity is the subject of an application for an authorisation or renewal of an authorisation or for a technical variation or surrender, the charge (after applying any other reduction) for all those activities which are reasonably associated with each other, other than the one for which the largest charge is payable, shall be reduced by 10%;

(b) an additional charge of £500 shall apply where SEPA incurs or will incur costs in relation to the advertisement of that application;

(c) an additional charge of £750 shall apply where an application includes a claim that information submitted should be regarded as commercially confidential and not subject to publication on a public register.

PART 3

ANNUAL CHARGES

Interpretation of this Part

9. In this Part -

“annual activity charge” means the charge set out in column 6 of the Table in the Schedule in respect of the corresponding activity set out in that Table;

“emission charge” means, in relation to each emission from an activity, the emission score multiplied by the emission financial factor, but there is no emission charge where –

- (a) the emission score is less than 1,
- (b) in the case of the abstraction of water, the abstraction rate is less than 2000 cubic metres per day,
- (c) in the case of the impounding of water, the volume impounded is less than 25 megalitres (ML);

“emission score” means the score accorded to an emission by SEPA under the Emissions Assessment Scheme, or otherwise as notified to the operator by SEPA;

“Compliance Assessment Scheme” means the scheme with that title published by SEPA on xxx, version yyy;

“Emissions Assessment Scheme” means the scheme with that title published by SEPA on xxx, version yyy;

“emission financial factor” means –

- (a) for emissions to air, x,
- (b) for discharges to water, x,
- (c) for the management of waste, x,
- (d) for the abstraction of water, x,
- (e) for the impounding of water, x;

“compliance factor” means –

- (a) For a compliance rating of “not assessed”, “compliant” or “broadly compliant”, 1,
- (b) For a compliance rating of “improvement required”, 1.2,

(c) For a compliance rating of “poor compliance”, 1.5,

(d) For a compliance rating of “very poor compliance”, 2,

but no compliance factor shall apply until 1st April 2018;

“compliance rating ” means the rating accorded to an authorisation by SEPA under the Compliance Assessment Scheme on -

(a) the relevant publication date,

(b) where SEPA has, on the relevant publication date, omitted to accord a rating or accorded a rating in error, the soonest date after the relevant publication date that SEPA is reasonably able to accord a rating or a revised rating, or

(c) where an authorisation is granted after the relevant publication date, the rating “not assessed” shall apply until the next relevant publication date;

“previous annual charge” means a charge of an equivalent type to the annual charge which was payable under a charging scheme listed in paragraph 6 of this Scheme, immediately before this Scheme came into force;

“relevant publication date” means the date or dates, prior to 1 April in any financial year, on which SEPA publishes the compliance ratings .

General

10. (1) An annual charge shall be payable for the subsistence of an authorisation, for any full or part financial year during which that authorisation is in force.

(2) Subject to paragraphs 11 and 12, and sub-paragraph (3), the annual charge, for each activity shall be $(A + B) \times C$, where –

A is the annual activity charge,

B is the emissions charge, and

C is the compliance factor.

(3)(a) Where more than one activity is the subject of an authorisation or takes place on the same site, the annual activity charge for each activity other than that to which the largest charge applies (“the first activity”), shall be reduced by –

(i) 75% in the case of each activity which falls in the same description in the Table in the Schedule, as the first activity,

(ii) 10%, in the case of every other activity;

(b) Where the annual activity charge is the relevant time and materials costs, the annual charge shall be those costs and sub-paragraphs (2) and (3) do not apply.

Mid-year adjustments

11. The following mid year adjustments shall be made, except in a case where the value of the adjustment is less than £100 –

(a) In the case of an authorisation which is revoked, surrendered, or varied after the date on which the annual charge is payable in any year, and in a way which would affect the calculation of the annual charge under this Scheme, the charge shall be adjusted pro rata so that no charge, or the appropriate revised charge, is payable from the date on which the revocation, surrender, transfer or variation (as the case may be), takes effect;

(b) In a case where SEPA considers that the operation of an activity has not commenced or has temporarily ceased, the annual charge shall be adjusted pro rata for the period during which SEPA considers that the activity is and remains un-commenced or in temporary cessation, by –

- (i) In the case of activities in the irrigation or fish farming sectors, ensuring that no charge is payable until 1st April 2018,
- (ii) In any other case, ensuring that the annual activity charge is reduced by 80 % and no emission charge applies;

(c) In a case where, by reason of a legislative amendment, or the exercise of powers by SEPA, after the date on which the annual charge is payable in any year, an authorised activity ceases to be required to be authorised or where the nature of the requirement to be authorised changes in a way which would affect the calculation of the annual charge, the annual charge shall be adjusted pro rata from the date of the relevant amendment so that no charge, or the appropriate revised charge, is payable from the date of the amendment.

Transitional arrangements.

12. Subject to paragraph 13, the annual charge shall be reduced or increased progressively by increments in each of the first five financial years in which this Scheme is in force, in the following manner –

- (a) Each increment shall be one fifth of the difference between the annual charge and the previous annual charge, and
- (b) In each new financial year, the increment shall be added to the charge payable in relation to the previous year, including any adjustment made under paragraph 3 of this Scheme.

Exclusions from transitional arrangements. 13. Paragraph 12 does not apply to -

- (a) Any activity that has not previously been liable to a charge under a charging scheme listed in paragraph 6 of this Scheme;
- (b) Any charges which reflect the costs of regulating a material recycling facility.
