2.7 NON-TECHNICAL SUMMARY

We request a new CAR licence for a proposed new site at Billy Baa, North Scalloway, Shetland. The proposal is for $9 \times 160 \text{m}$ circumference pens and $1 \times 120 \text{m}$ circumference pen moored within a 125 m grid, as shown on the plans provided (Attachments A and B). An automated feed barge is also proposed to service the site, to be installed off the west side of the pen group.

Modelled biomass consent for the new site is 4091 T. In the event of the site being consented, Scottish Sea Farms propose to relinquish all consents on four nearby sites; namely Brei Geo Inshore (CAR/L/1004156), Brei Geo Offshore (CAR/L/1001818), Sandsound Voe (WPC/N/62087) and Sandsound Bixter (WPC/N/62089). The combined biomass currently licensed at these four sites is 4944 T, so there would be an overall decrease in consented tonnage of 813 T in the area.
