


Restoring the River Leven Large Wood

The restoration proposals for the River Leven include design features involving the placement of large pieces of natural wood consisting of a tree trunk and its root plate within the river.

These features often occur naturally and help shape the flow and nature of the river. They help create pools of deeper slower water which provide habitat and nursery areas for fish and invertebrates.

Being a natural material, wood is not only sustainable with a minimal carbon footprint but also provides important ecological benefits such as cover for fish, invertebrates and birds.

The use of large pieces of wood in river restoration is a tried and tested approach and there are numerous examples where its use has resulted in significant improvements to the river and the quality of the habitats it supports.
